



Banbury Hockey Club - Weekend Cook Position for Match Teas

About the Club

Banbury Hockey Club (BHC) is an ambitious club which seeks to benefit all of its members as well as the community in which it exists. We run 10 adult league teams, 8 junior teams, as well as a mixed and two veteran team. We are well known for our welcoming and inclusive culture. BHC has a clubhouse at North Oxfordshire Academy, where the majority of our hospitality is based. There are many social events throughout the year that are put on in order to bring club members closer together, get to know people from other teams and perhaps even make some friends that will last you a lifetime!

The Role and working environment

We are seeking a new weekend match teas cook for our hockey club who will be able to manage a weekly budget in order to purchase and provide delicious hot and cold meals for our hungry players following their grueling Saturday matches! The successful candidate would work to ensure the smooth running of the kitchen in order to provide timely food on match days, ready for each team when they finish their matches. They would work alongside the bar manager on match days within the bar and kitchen area of the clubhouse.

Required Skills/Qualifications

Qualifications:

- Maths and English GCSE or equivalent

Skills:

- The ability to produce delicious simple meals for the teams
- Numerical and stock taking skills
- Ability to effectively manage a weekly budget of £20 per hockey team.
- Ability to work under pressure on busy match days
- Ability to meet deadlines and serve food in a timely manner to all teams
- Ability to work well with others
- Very good communication skills
- A friendly and welcoming disposition

Opportunities and job perks

The successful candidate would receive the following perks in addition to remuneration:

- No match fees (where appropriate)
- One free (non-alcoholic) drink on match days

All of the above is based on the successful candidate providing and cooking match teas to all teams every match day during the hockey season and during weekend club events (where required).

Main duties and responsibilities

- To manage a weekly budget per team in order to provide enough food for every team on match day at the clubhouse



- To purchase all food and drink required in order to feed all players on match day (using the committee approved budget)
- To prepare, cook and serve hot and cold meals to all teams on match day (up to 5 matches in total, so 5 rounds of food required on these days but can be less if fewer home matches on that week)
- To provide the above service on the occasional weekend club event day as well as match days during the hockey season (October to April)
- To clean up after the food has been consumed and ensure all cutlery, dishes and pots and pans are cleaned and tidied away before the end of the shift.
- To ensure the kitchen area is kept clean and tidy at all times.

Hours of work: Saturdays during hockey season (October to April) from 10am to 7pm (could be shorter hours if fewer matches occur on that day). Events days - hours vary depending on the event but would generally be less hours than match days.

Remuneration

This role is a paid position at £10 an hour.

Please note that the position is for an independent contractor willing to provide their services on a self-employed basis. This would be a rolling contract for the right candidate.
